**ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT  
(Academic Session 2019-2020)**


The institution collects feedbacks every year within the academic session from the alumni. They are supplied with a printed MCQ style questionnaire. The parameters of the feedback include the curriculum taught, concerning the innovative approach of the syllabus as well as its relevance in present context, employability skills, quality and quantity of books/journals/reference books available in the central library, teaching-learning and evaluation process, institutional approach in inculcating employability skills in students, institutional infrastructure etc.

Feedback form has been designed to seek feedback from alumni to strengthen the quality of teaching-learning environment and to improve the overall performance of the institution. A total of 58 Nos. of feedback forms have been collected from the alumni during the session 2019-2020.

The questionnaires of alumni feedback forms emphasizing on the curriculum, teaching-learning process, institutional infrastructure and environment. Alumni are to select their ranking on the scale of 1 to 5 for each of the following parameters.

2. Some alumni suggested that curriculum should have still more practical approaches.
3. Some alumni suggested that there should be smart learning environment using ICT classrooms.
4. Some alumni suggested that due to COVID-19 pandemic, students suffered a heavy academic loss and so in order to fill up that loss, teachers should initiate more online classes for the greater benefit of the students.

**Action Taken:**


The college has collected the feedbacks from alumni regarding their subject curriculum in view of identifying the gap in the curriculum. Suggestions like more smart and experiential leaning and approach to competitive exams, relevant to the framing of the syllabus of various courses were consolidated and discussed in IQAC, then communicated to the subject teachers.
