Student Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report (Academic Session 2018-2019)

The institution collects feedbacks every year within the academic session from those students who are regular in their classes. They are supplied with a pre-printed MCQ style questionnaire. A short counseling session is conducted on how to fill up the MCQ sheet and the meaning of various parameters is explained to participant students. The parameters of the feedback include the curriculum taught, teaching-learning and evaluation process, institutional approach in inculcating employability skills in students, institutional infrastructure etc.

Feedback form has been designed to seek feedback from students to strengthen the quality of teaching-learning environment and to improve the overall performance. A total of 192 Nos. of feedback forms have been collected from 6th semester students within the academic session. The institution collects feedbacks from the final year students (6th Semester) keeping in view that they are well acquainted with their program curriculum, teaching-learning and evaluation process, institutional efforts in inculcating employability skills, institutional infrastructural facilities provided to the students etc. The information provided by the students has been kept confidential.

The questionnaires of student feedback forms emphasizing on the curriculum, teaching-learning process, institutional infrastructure and environment Students are to select their ranking on the scale of 1 to 5 for each of the following parameters.

(1- strongly disagree, 2- disagree, 3- uncertain, 4- agree, 5- strongly agree)



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Suggestions from students:

- 1. A few students suggested for introducing English Honor Program and PGDCA or any other computer certificate course in the institution.
- 2. A few students suggested that there is an urgent need to setup computer laboratory with high-speed internet.
- 3. A few students felt that the syllabus should have more approach to competitive exams like UPSC, APSC and SSC etc.
- 4. A few students suggested that curriculum should have still more practical approaches.
- 5. A few students suggested that there should be smart learning environment using ICT classrooms.
- 6. Text books as well as reference books were purchased for the central library in order to benefit the students.

Action Taken:

The college has collected the feedbacks from the students regarding their subject curriculum in view of identifying the gap in the curriculum. Suggestions like more smart and experiential leaning and approach to competitive exams, relevant to the framing of the syllabus of various courses were consolidated and discussed in IQAC, then communicated to the subject teachers.

As suggested by IQAC following actions were prominently taken:

- 1. Initiatives were taken for introducing English Honours as well as PGDCA Program in the institution.
- 2. Career guidance lectures were conducted for the benefit of the students.
- 3. Teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process. Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.
- 4. Extension activities for social and environment sensitization are conducted.

Conclusion:

The feedbacks collected from the students were analyzed and suitable actions were taken in order to satisfy the expectations of students.

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
