It is a selfless service to the community. It was established in the year 2017 and since its establishment it has been providing its service in a continuous manner.

Keeping close proximity with the objectives, we collect old and used clothes of good and usable condition. Besides clothes we collect shoes, school bags, and backpacks etc. which are not in active use. The institution has a dedicated committee to maintain the relevant functions of the cloth bank. The committee approach households through Borholla College fraternity including all teachers, employees and students. Awareness regarding the campaign is also done by distributing pamphlets locally. It is also posted in the website of the institution. The clothes and other material after receipt are recorded in the register. These are inspected and thereafter graded category-wise, age-wise, season-wise and put in proper cover designed for the purpose with dedicated stickers on it. After that these are stored appropriately. The stickers pasted on the covers distinctly reflect the benevolent practice of the institution done through the cloth bank. When flood and any other calamities occur and when the committee feels it necessary, distribute these among the needy. When we receive any amount of material as donation we reciprocate with gratitude and issue an appreciation letter instantly.
